Savage Frontier could just as easily been titled *Savage Frontiersmen*. Stephen L. Moore's second tome traces "the early days of the Texas frontier defense system" (p. ix). As a genealogical source it is a great resource; as a historical resource it is a good source, but overall it is not an easy read. Early on, Moore acknowledges, "few accounts exist to paint the picture from the point of view of the Native Americans involved in these 1830s battles" (p. xi).
