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## An Introduction to Early Childhood Special Education: Birth to Age Five

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Foundational course in Early Childhood Education. Emphasis is on developing skills and knowledge needed to work effectively with children, birth to age 8. Introduction to building relationships, developing guidance and supervision skills, observation techniques, curriculum planning, professionalism, and reflective practice. Requires 45 (3 hour shifts) in ECE lab. The seminar provides an introduction to teaching methods, curriculum and learning materials development, classroom management, and establishing a relationship with students. A practicum experience in a local school is required. Special emphasis given to the child from birth to age five in relation to cultural, gender, class and racial influences.
